Planning a project outdoors? Follow this chart to find out if you should locate buried infrastructure, such as pipelines, before you start.

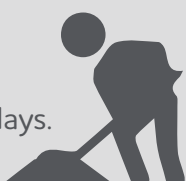


A professional locate is the only way to know for sure if and where underground utilities are located near your project. No matter how small your project, you should always Click Before You Dig. clickbeforeyoudig.com

What should I do after I click?

- ➔ Wait until the lines are located! Utility operators will contact you or will mark their facilities with paint or flags, usually within 2 -3 business days.
- ➔ Follow instructions from the utility operator.
- ➔ Dig with care! Report any damages immediately.
- ➔ Pipeline company locates are valid for up to 14 days.



Pipeline damage: The facts

~ 119,000 kms of transmission pipelines are operated by CEPA members in Canada.

One of the most common causes of damage to these pipelines? Construction and excavation by third parties.
